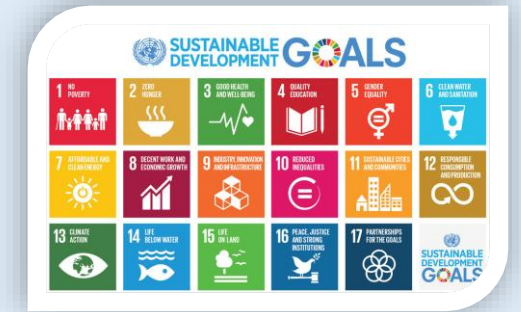

Our vision is to contribute to sustainable development and to help achieve the development goals (Agenda 2030). By 2015, the UN decided to adopt 17 development goals and some are directly or indirectly linked to dressings and wound care.

Dressings and wound care is an important category for the county councils and regions who consume large volumes of these products. The articles are important for the patients from a health-economic perspective. In Sweden focuses on patient safety and the function of the material. On the other hand, not as much focus has been on the risks of human rights and workers' rights in the supply chain.

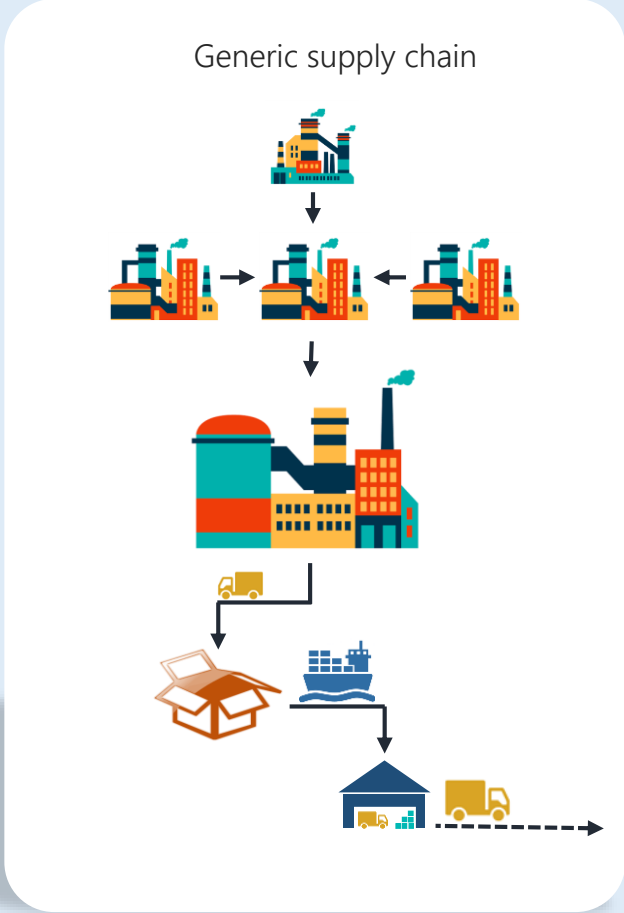

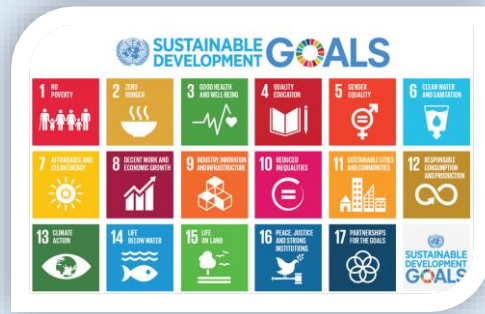

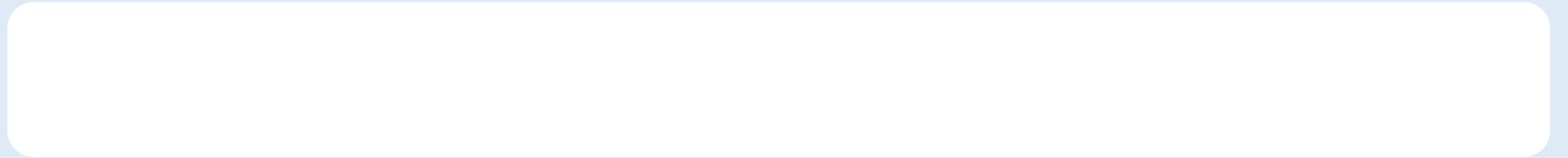
